

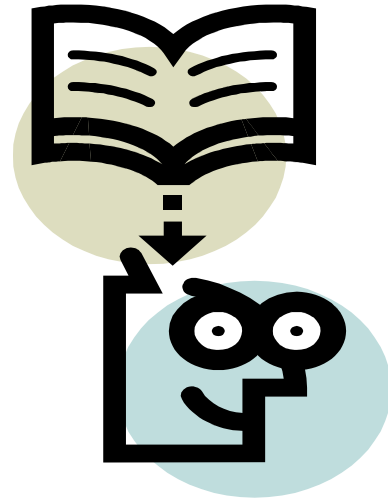

The **English** department requests that students have the following items to help them keep organized for class as well as help them be successful for the school year.

- An Agenda book for homework and activities (any calendar type assignment notebook will do if the student or parent does not wish to purchase a school Agenda notebook)
- a 1 ½ inch 3-ring binder
- 5 dividers with tabs
- Pens (blue, black)
- 3 x 5 lined white and colored index cards (need about 100 per term)
- 2 highlighters (at least one yellow, then any other color you wish)
- 3 hole punched white-lined paper for binder (100 sheets to start the year)
- a single subject 3-hole punched **spiral-bound** notebook with a minimum of 70 pages.

If you did not get or misplaced the Summer Reading Lists for SY0809, please check out our website at www.norfolkaggie.org for the lists for your grade level! If your child does not have access to the Internet at home, the local public library should have that access. Remember that

- all students are required to read one book over the summer;
- students in level 1 must read two books;
- one extra credit activity may be completed during the summer on a book; and
- the first Friday of the first full week of school, students may bring in a 3 x 5 index card with information about their book to help them while doing the writing assessment for their summer reading.
